Below are average prices for quality, professional floral designs, based on industry standards and the common prices found in our store. These numbers may vary a great deal when determining specific flowers used, design, etc.

<i>Bridesmaids' Bouquets (each)</i>	<i>\$60 – \$90</i>
<i>Flower Girl Basket or Bouquet</i>	<i>\$35 – \$50</i>
<i>Corsages (each)</i>	<i>\$25 – \$40</i>
<i>Boutonnieres (each)</i>	<i>\$12 – \$15</i>
<i>Large Altar Arrangements (each)</i>	<i>\$150 – \$200</i>
<i>Centerpieces (each)</i>	<i>\$65 – \$125</i>
<i>Delivery, Setup, and Breakdown</i>	<i>15% to 20% of the total bill</i>

(Don't forget to include taxes on the entire amount.)
