

Dill's Wedding Flower To-Do

6 - 12 Months Before the Wedding:

— First meeting with us to discuss flower types and colors, bouquet styles, wedding theme, pricing/budget, etc.

If you want to be extra prepared for your appointment, here are some ideas of items to bring with you: bridesmaid dress color swatch(es), photos (bridal gown, bridesmaid dresses, inside of the church, reception location, tuxedos, bouquet styles, flower types, etc.), Dill's Wedding Flower Checklist, a friend or family member, notes of folder of wedding ideas (or your phone to check out Pinterest, too! ☺), and anything else you've used to plan your big day!

2 - 4 Months Before the Wedding:

— Meet with or call your Dill's Wedding Designer to finalize your flowers, and arrange to bring or mail any color swatches/photos/inspirations discussed at the first meeting, if not already done, and make any changes or corrections to your quote and order.

1 Month Before the Wedding:

— Final conversations for the flower-planning stage; make all adjustments, and arrange with your designer to send out flowers thanking those who hosted/will host the bridal shower, bachelorette party, and other pre-wedding events.

2 -3 Weeks Before the Wedding:

— Pay any remaining balance due on your flower order if not done. Finalize any delivery, pick-up, or servicing time and details with your designer.
